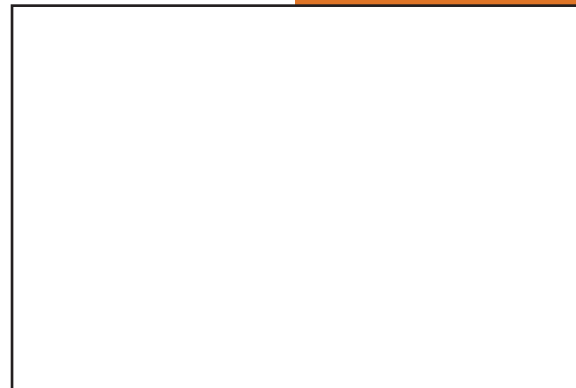

In life, most accidents and lost opportunities are the result of things you don't see. The barriers in our financial lives are the result of only knowing what we know and seeing only what we see.

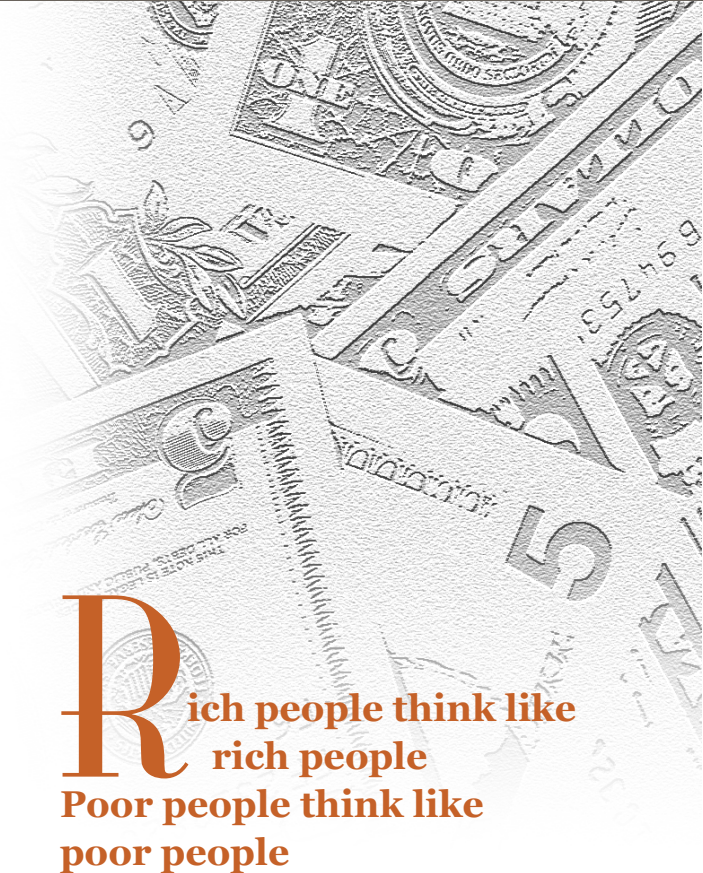
In order to preserve your family's financial future, you must discover the things you don't see.

- #3** Rule 3 Create multiples of wealth immediately with certainty
